WHAT: Lifeline Theatre KidSeries presents the world premiere kids' musical, a stirring tale of spudly courage,

BRAVE POTATOES, based on the popular book by **Toby Speed** and **Barry Root**, adapted by Lifeline ensemble member **James E. Grote**, music and lyrics by **George Howe**, directed by Lifeline ensemble member **Shole Milos** (the same trio that brought *CLICK*, *CLACK*, *MOO*; *GIGGLE*, *GIGGLE*, *QUACK*; and *DEEP IN THE JUNGLE* to the Lifeline stage). **BRAVE POTATOES** chronicles the heroic adventures of three young potatoes who must defeat the chowder-making Chef Hackemup to save themselves, while reminding us that vegetables have feelings too. The show runs approximately 50 minutes with no intermission and is recommended for ages five and up. KidSeries is in its 19th anniversary season.
