Our ensemble process supports writers in the development of literary adaptations and new work, and our theatrical and educational programs foster a lifelong engagement with literature and the arts. SUMMER TEACHING INTERNS support our drama programs for youth. Interns receive training and mentorship from some of the best drama teachers in Chicago through our classes and camps, and the opportunity for leadership in the classroom and beyond. We are seeking two to three motivated, energetic individuals to assist on our programs who have some experience working with children and a desire to learn more about the teaching artist profession. The internship is unpaid for class time, but there are stipends available for before- and after care hours.

OUR PROGRAMS are from June 29th – July 31st. Interns should be available every day between 9 am – 3 pm, or 8 am – 5 pm for those interns who can provide paid care before and/or after camp. The programs themselves are:

Drama Kids: Ages 5-7. July 6 – July 10 (Session 1); July 13 – July 17 (Session 2); 9am to 12pm.

Drama Stars 1: Ages 7-10. June 29 – July 10

Drama Stars 2: Ages 10-14. July 13 – July 24; 9am to 3pm (Full Day) or 9am to 12 noon (Half-Day).

Lifeline Theatre Intensive: Ages 7-14. July 27 – July 31
