The safety of our artists and patrons is of utmost importance to us at Lifeline, and so we have decided it is in everyone's best interest to suspend public activities at this time. We hope that this effort and the actions of all of our peer theaters throughout the city will help reduce community spread.

*Middle Passage*, *Neither*, and *Gaudy Night* ticketholders are being contacted with options to reschedule their tickets toward a future production date or donate the ticket to help mitigate the inevitable financial impact of COVID-19 on our artists and our theatre during this time.
